1. Bildung: had + past participle ("3. Spalte" / ed-Form)

Aussage- I / you / he had (not) opened the window.

satz:

Frage: Had I/you/he... (not) opened the window?

Kurz- "had" kann man zu 'd abkürzen:

formen: I had / he had I'd / he'd

1a. Die Bildung der -ed-Form: Rechtschreibregeln

1. Bei einem –e am Wortende hängt man nur –d an. **bake -> baked**

2. y nach Konsonant (!) wird zu –ie-: carry -> carried

(! y nach Vokal: play -> played)

3. ein einfacher Konsonant nach einem kurzen (!), betonten (!!) stop -> stopped

Vokal wird verdoppelt: (! langer Vokal: heal -> healed)

(! letzte Silbe unbetont: **ó**pen -> ópened)

2. Verwendung und Signalwörter

Das *past perfect* verwendet man oft zusammen mit dem <u>simple past</u>, um auszudrücken, dass eine Handlung vor einer anderen stattfindet. Die frühere Handlung steht im *past perfect*.

After Susan had eaten three pieces of cake, she felt sick.

– Nachdem Susan drei Stücke Kuchen **gegessen hatte**, <u>war</u>ihr schlecht.

Before he <u>moved</u> to Canada, Sam <u>had</u> never <u>seen</u> snow.

- Bevor er nach Kanada zog, hatte Sam noch nie Schnee gesehen.
